## SAFETY MEETING

1. Call to Order  
Meeting called to order at 8:22 by Chair Ashley Winn
2. Members in Attendance

3. Approve Minutes of Last Meeting

4. Review and Discussion of Employee/Patrons Accident/Incident Reports.  
Assault occurred at Improvement Association meeting in October. Sheriff called, no serious injury.
5. Staff Safety Training  
None to Report.
6. Site Inspections  
All completed. Findings:
  - Some yellowing and bare spots on Florido Lawn back in September. These were resolved via landscaper Powers and CLI.
  - Light on Flag Pole in Robin's Park became non-operational and Serrano still looking into best solutions (cheapest and easiest). Byron Shugart suggests DM do it with a lift, but DM is looking for a company to do it instead.
  - September – There was some dumping of old outdoor furniture on the bluff. A work order was started with the County. It was removed by some residents.
  - Trash was an issue on 9/26 site inspection at Triangle Park. The trash can will be removed, but now that summer is over, the major trash issues seem to have resolved themselves (for now).
  - Clubhouse plants (madrone, rose bushes, and maple tree (by library)) along with the cottage plants (decorative front plant and side oak) need to be trimmed away from the roofs. Animals and ants are using them as ladders. DM will cut back the plants.
  - Political signs will be removed come 11/9/2022 or after (Ian's Park).

8. New Business  
-Landscaper will remove rebars being used to secure gopher traps and replace them with a less hazardous method.

-The library is working to develop a better schedule for turning on the light on the Florido lawn near the entrance. Light should be operating when there are nighttime events at the Clubhouse.
